## Dress Code 2023-2024

Veritas Classical School has a standardized dress code. The ultimate goal with our dress code is modesty and neatness. Since the time spent in class is limited, we would ask that dress code not become an issue. If you arrive at Veritas dressed immodestly or inappropriately, your parent will be called to bring appropriate clothes to school. Please adhere to this dress code and sign the requirements stated below.

<b>Shirts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>classic polo shirt</b>: solid or striped, long or short sleeved</li><li>• <b>oxford shirt or blouse</b>: solid, striped, flannel, or plaid</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• unbuttoned shirts worn as a jacket</li><li>• shirts other than traditional oxfords or cotton cloth shirts</li><li>• old, faded flannel shirts</li><li>• No polka dot, print or animals design, etc.</li><li>• No short shirts or blouses for girls</li></ul>
<b>Pants/Capris, Shorts, Skirts, Dresses, Skorts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>traditional pants</b></li><li>• <b>capris</b></li><li>• <b>knee length shorts</b></li><li>• <b>knee length skirt</b></li><li>• <b>knee length jumper</b></li><li>• <b>knee length skort</b></li><li>• <u>colors</u>: navy, khaki, black, gray, green, white, or brown ONLY</li><li>• <u>plaid</u>: classic navy plaid (skirts and jumpers ONLY(<a href="http://www.landsend.com">www.landsend.com</a>))</li><li>• leggings worn under a skirt must be knee length and in one of the above approved colors.</li><li>• NO frayed or holes on pants</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• jeans</li><li>• colored jeans</li><li>• skin tight pants or shorts</li><li>• leggings</li><li>• jeggings</li><li>• yoga pants</li><li>• layered or slitted skirts</li><li>• <b>pants must be hemmed and not have unfinished seams</b></li></ul>
<b>Coats, Jackets, Sweaters, Sweatshirts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>a jacket, sweater, or sweatshirt may be worn over a collared shirt</b></li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>no hoodies on head on campus</b></li><li>• sweatshirts without a collared shirt are not acceptable</li></ul>
<b>Shoes, Accessories, Appearance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• shoe color and style are at the parents' discretion</li><li>• natural hair color</li><li>• boys should have neatly cut hair and no longer than chin length</li><li>• clean and neat students</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>hats (beanies, toboggans, ball caps)</b></li><li>• <b>earrings for boys</b></li><li>• <b>nose or other piercings</b></li><li>• <b>unusual hair color</b></li><li>• <b>No ponytails or Man Buns for boys</b></li></ul>

### **Math and Science:**

The dress code is the same as above except that the students may wear jeans, skirts, skorts or jumpers. The length of skirts and shorts is also **knee length**.

**Polo or collared shirts are required.**

**Jeans that are frayed, slits, or have holes are not acceptable.**

### **Relax Dress Days:**

Relax Dress days are designated on the school calendar. This is not a time to wear whatever you would like. All clothes that are worn during Relax Dress week must still abide by dress code modesty guidelines. Girls may not wear dresses, shorts, and skirts that are shorter than knee length. Girls may not wear sundresses, short shorts, or tank tops. Boys and girls may not wear athletic shorts or sports apparel. Students may wear jeans, t-shirts, or shirts without collars.
