### VCS High School Transcript Documentation Instructions

**Course Documentation -** If a course was taught and completed at home by a parent or tutor, the following information must be provided to document the course. The parent or tutor must submit the following information for each subject on the "Home Study Course Sheet" provided by Veritas. Please fill out the form completely. Be sure to include the following:

- Numeric Grade per semester (not percentages, DO NOT average the two semesters)
- Number of hours spent on the subject (60 hours =  $\frac{1}{2}$  credit/ 120 hours = 1 credit)
- High school courses taken in 8<sup>th</sup> need to be included.
- Parent or tutor signature
- Two (2) Examples of Assessments (Test, Quiz, Short Essay, etc.)

  NOTE: For Physical Education/Music lessons, please attach a log of hours with activities listed.

SCAN documents, put into a PDF file by course, and Email all documentation to transcripts@veritasschools.com. Do not send photos.

**School Documentation** - If a course was taught and completed at a local school or through an accredited program then please ask the institution to send us a Report Card or Transcript with all of the relevant data (courses, grades, dates, etc.).

Credits for graduation - Through instructional time, a student must accumulate 120 hours per year per course for 1 Carnegie Unit or 60 hours per semester per course for ½ Carnegie Unit. A student is required to have a minimum of 24 credits (or Carnegie Units) in specific courses to graduate from Veritas. Students are also expected to have a minimum of four (4) HOPE Rigor Courses.

Veritas requests that all incoming seniors send their course information to the school during the summer BEFORE their senior year. This will allow us time to enter data and create a transcript to keep on file. This will be important as seniors start to apply for colleges, seek dual enrollment and HOPE Scholarship funds, etc. *Please do not wait until the last minute to provide us with this important information.* 

Transcripts take a minimum of two (2) weeks to update.
