- □ Read Proverbs 4:1-27 and 27:1-12. Discuss these verses with a parent. Discussion questions:
 - What does prudent mean?
 - How can your heart retain God's Word? (Proverbs 4:4)
 - Memory Verse: The prudent see danger and take refuge, but the simple keep going and suffer for it. Proverbs 27:12
- □ Key Themes:
 - The wise person looks ahead
 - The wise person sees danger and hides from it (look ahead and makes good choices)
 - The wise person sees beyond immediate results to eventual consequences
 - The wise person corrects his swerving to the right or the left (corrects a wrong direction)
- □ Finish your sketch.
- □ Pray for your mom and dad during the holidays.
