- € Respond to these questions in your journal:
  - \*\*How do they describe the coming savior?
  - \*\*Do you think that's what the Israelites were expecting? Why or why not?

**Memory Verse Passage:** Psalm 63:1-5. Be prepared to write out **verse 5** in class from memory next week. Review verse 1-4.

## Writing: Ancient History-Based Writing Lessons/Student Resource Book
